Sir Winston Churchill was the prime minister who led the country to victory against Nazi Germany and the Axis powers.

**Harry S. Truman**

Harry Truman became president after Roosevelt died. He had to make the call to use the atomic bomb against Japan.

**Joseph Stalin**  
*Soviet Union*

Joseph Stalin was a dictator that instituted a reign of terror in Russia, killing millions. He played a key role in the defeat of Nazism.

*France*



William Lyon Mackenzie King was the prime minister of Canada that joined World War 2 beside Great Britain when the war started.

**Sir Robert Menzies**

Sir Robert Menzies was Australia's longest serving prime minister who joined forces with Great Britain in World War 2.

**Adolf Hitler**

Adolf Hitler was the leader of Nazi Germany, initiated World War II and oversaw fascist policies that resulted in millions of deaths.

**Hideki Tōjō**

As Prime Minister of Japan, Hideki Tojo was a major supporter of the Tripartite Pact with Germany and Italy.

“ The moment the first American soldier sets foot on the Japanese mainland, all prisoners of war will be shot.



**Emperor Hirohito**  
*Japan*

Hirohito was the Emperor of Japan. During World War 2 he led Japan's military and the country's surrender to the Allied Forces.

**Benito Mussolini**  
*Italy*

Benito Mussolini created the Fascist party in 1919, eventually making himself dictator prior to World War 2, until being killed in 1945.
