

FRACTIONS

MIXED, IMPROPER AND EQUIVALENT



numerator
denominator

MIXED → IMPROPER

$$4\frac{3}{5} = \frac{23}{5}$$

$$(4 \times 5) + 3 = 23$$

DENOMINATOR STAYS THE SAME

IMPROPER → MIXED

$$\frac{25}{4} = 6\frac{1}{4}$$

$$25 \div 4 = 6 \text{ remainder } 1$$

DENOMINATOR STAYS THE SAME

EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS

MULTIPLY OR DIVIDE THE NUMERATOR AND DENOMINATOR BY THE SAME WHOLE NUMBER.

$$\frac{4}{6} \stackrel{\times 2}{=} \frac{8}{12}$$

$$\frac{8}{12} \stackrel{\div 4}{=} \frac{2}{3}$$

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$$\frac{4}{6} \begin{matrix} \times 2 \\ = \\ \times 2 \end{matrix} \frac{8}{12}$$

$$\frac{8}{12} \begin{matrix} \div 4 \\ = \\ \div 4 \end{matrix} \frac{2}{3}$$
