Carolina Parakeet

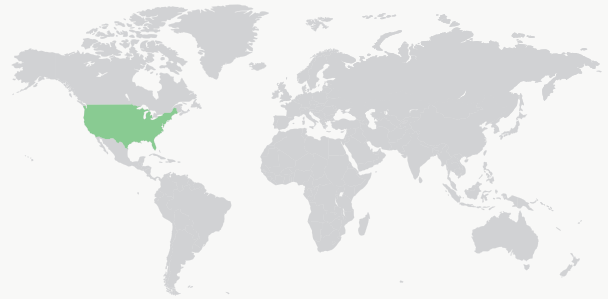
Carolina Conure

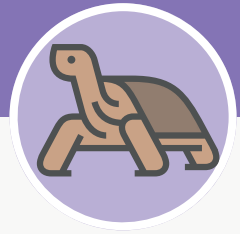
